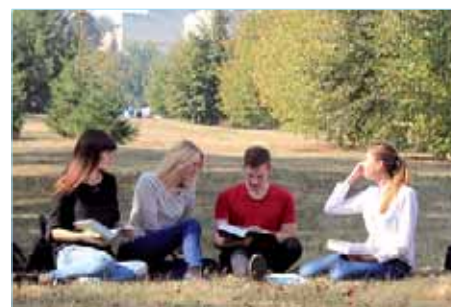
IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Foreign diplomas recognition
Every foreign citizen who wishes to study in Ukraine is required to undergo the procedure of their educational documents recognition at the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

Admission requirements
We check that candidates have finished full secondary education and they have higher than average marks in Mathematics and Physics, but each case is individual. If candidates wish to enter the course in English medium of instruction they undergo language test upon arrival. The successful candidates will receive a positive reply to their email with extensive and detailed information about the following steps to take, i.e. issue of invitation, application for visa, arrival to Ukraine and more.



NATIONAL AEROSPACE UNIVERSITY KHA I



The number of books and periodicals in KhAI library is 904,000. Annually library receives about 12,000 of new materials. The university offers automated library system: <http://library.khai.edu>

About 1,000 professors and 2,500 employees work in KhAI. Among them there are 550 PhD and Doctors of Science. Teaching staff regularly take part in international programs. University lecturers provide classes in Ukrainian, Russian and English languages.

There are around 9,000 students in KhAI, 1,000 of whom are from abroad. 8 faculties offer 54 BCH, 60 MS programs and different PhD research programs; dual degree courses are also available.



KhAI is participating in such fundraising programs as ERASMUS+, HORIZON2020, TEMPUS. Moreover the University trains foreign experts in aerospace field and provides intership for international students in winter and summer schools.

KhAI has a separate campus in the forest-park zone. It has 8 academic buildings, halls of residence, research institute, laboratories, sport complex, swimming pool, medical center, dining halls and bank.

KhAI is a member of IAU/UNESCO, European association of aviation scientists (EASN), European aviation partnership of universities PEGASUS. In 2010 KhAI joined the Great Charter of Universities (Magna Charta Universitatum).



DOCUMENTS TO ENTER KHA I

1. International passport with student's visa
2. Original of school certificate and school transcripts (apostilled by Ministry of Education of home country or equivalent legal body)
3. Original of BCH diploma and transcripts (apostilled by Ministry of Education of home country or equivalent legal body) if any
4. 6 photos 60 x 40 mm
5. Birth certificate.
6. Original of medical certificate with issue date no earlier than 2 months before commencing the training
7. Original of document certifying negative test results for HIV
8. Original of Invitation for training

The following documents must be translated to Ukrainian language in Ukraine upon arrival of the student (translations should be notarized):

1. Passport's 1st page - 2 copies
2. School certificate and school transcripts (2 copies)
3. Original of BCH diploma and transcripts (2 copies) if any
4. Medical certificate and HIV test (1 copy)

UKRAINE

Ukraine is a beautiful and ecologically clean country situated in the center of Europe. It is a member of UN Organization, International Monetary Fund, European Council and many others.

Territory of Ukraine is about 600,000 sq.km. Population is about 42 million people. The capital is Kyiv. The key industries of Ukraine are aerospace, metallurgical, engineering, mining, chemical, refining and agricultural.

Ukraine is the largest country in Europe. It owns 1/4 of the planet's black soil resources. Ukrainians are the 1st in the world who developed AN-225 airplane with the maximum capacity (Antonov State Enterprise).



KHARKIV

Kharkiv is the 2nd largest city in Ukraine after Kyiv and former capital of Ukraine. It is the main transport hub of South-Eastern Europe and one of industrial, academic and scientific Ukrainian centers.

Territory of Kharkiv is more than 300 sq. km. Population is more than 1.5 million people. The city has 270 industrial enterprises, international airport, railway and bus stations, and subway.

Kharkiv has 45 higher educational establishments, 142 research institutes, 230,000 students, 16 museums, 6 theatres, 80 libraries, 5 large parks, zoos, dolphinarium and planetarium.
