Dr. Tanel Kerikmäe, Director of Tallinn Law School and Archil Chochia (Tallinn University of Technology) visited National Law University. During the meeting with the Rector Vasyl Tatsii, Vice-Rector Iurii Barabash and project team, they discussed Erasmus+ HRLAW. ## OPEN LECTURE ON THE LEGAL PRINCIPLES OF CYBERSECURITY IN NATIONAL AEROSPACE UNIVERSITY n. a. N. E. ZHUKOVSKY "KHAI", KHARKIV, UKRAINE

On March 6, 2018, at the Department of Computer Systems, Networks and Cybersecurity of National Aerospace University n. a. N. E. Zhukovsky "Kharkiv Aviation Institute", Ukraine an open lecture on the legal principles of cybersecurity with the participation of law lecturers from the Tallinn Technical University, Estonia.

The event was organized within the framework of the Erasmus + HRLAW project of the European Union. The lecture was attended by students and post-graduate students of the Department of Computer Systems, Networks and Cybersecurity (503) and students of the first year of the department of law (702).

The issues of the actual legal framework in the field of cyber security, adaptation of the European Union's right to existing challenges in the field of information security, national regulations in the field of e-commerce, privacy protection, etc. were considered.


