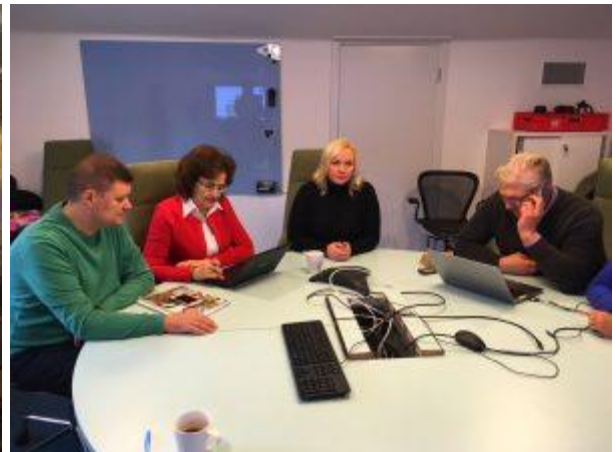
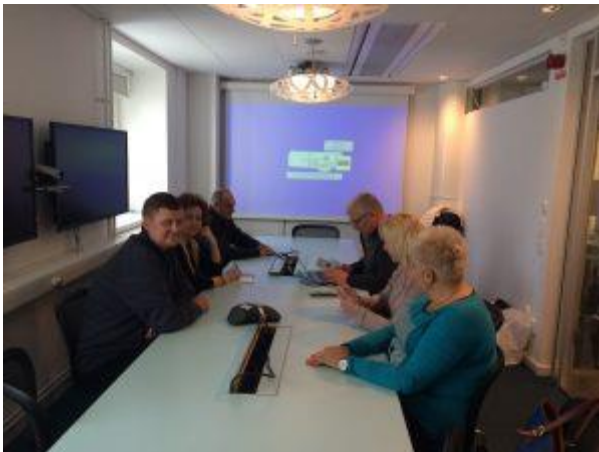

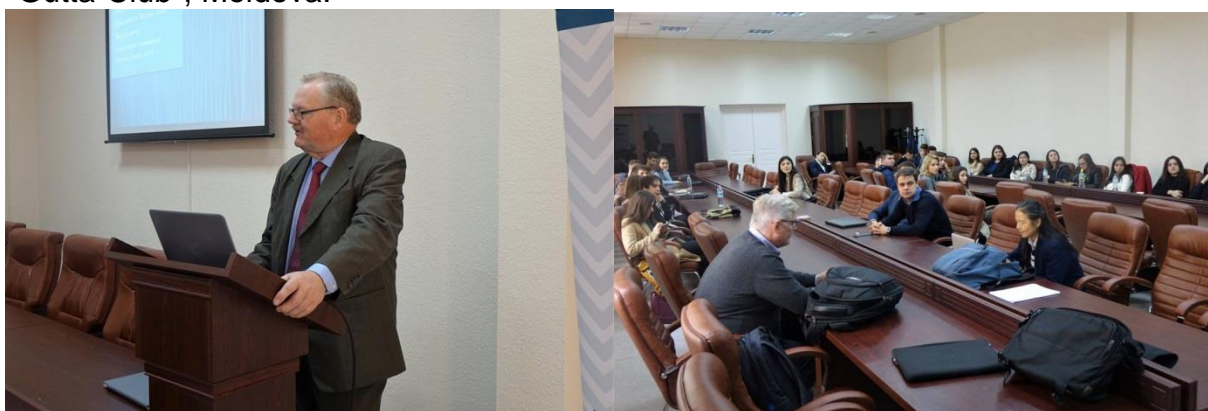
HRLAW GUEST LECTURES IN MOLDOVA STATE UNIVERSITY
