## 2. Description of the discipline

**Semester in which the discipline is taught** - 1

**Scope of the discipline:** 3 ECTS credits / 90 hours, including classroom - 48 hours, independent work of applicants - 42 hours.

**The form of education** is full-time

**Discipline** - selective

**Types of educational activities** - lectures, practical classes

**Types of control** - current, modular and final (semester).

**The language of instruction** is Ukrainian

**Required prior courses (prerequisites)** - Ukrainian as a foreign language.

**Required related subjects (co-requisites)** - Ukrainian as a foreign language.

## 3. The purpose and objectives of the discipline

**Purpose:** to form students' ability to practically use the necessary speech skills in all types of speech activities to ensure the possibility of everyday communication in the Ukrainian language environment.

**Tasks:** to master the norms of the spoken Ukrainian language; to develop communication skills, ie to effectively perform acts of oral communication during communication.

**Acquired competencies:** the ability to communicate in the state language both orally and in writing for effective communication; ability to search, process and analyze information from various sources to meet the information needs of consumers; ability to reproduce already known and recognize new lexical units, use them in appropriate communicative situations; ability to further study with a high level of autonomy, constant improvement of information culture.

**Expected learning outcomes:** to know the rules of functioning of the Ukrainian language as a foreign language, to use them in speech and thinking activities; communicate on various issues in Ukrainian; knowledge of verbal and nonverbal means and ways of expressing thoughts, feelings; ability to use language depending on the field and situations of communication; have the skills of interpersonal communication.

##### **Topic 1. Acquaintance.**

- *form of classes: lectures, practical classes, independent work.*

- *practical classes: "Learning phonetics" "Greetings, farewells, requests, acquaintances" "Countries and nationalities".*

- *required items and means (equipment, machinery, materials, tools: none*

Alphabet. The difference between the Latin and Cyrillic alphabets.

Proper names of people common in Ukraine. Use of personal pronouns. Etiquette phrases for greetings, farewells, polite requests, acquaintances.

Names of countries and nationalities. The genitive case of nouns. Formation of the feminine gender from masculine nouns - names of nationalities. Formation of constructions such as: speak Ukrainian, speak Ukrainian.

- *volume of independent work of applicants: 6*

Elaboration and mastering of lecture and practical material on the topics "Alphabet. Sounds and letters." "Numerals 1-10.", Preparation for the next practical classes. Forming questions to the teacher.

##### **Topic 2. Man.**

- *form of classes: lectures, practical classes, independent work.*

- *volume of classroom load: 4 -2.*

- *practical classes: "Family", "Professions", "Hobbies".*

- *Mandatory items and means (equipment, machinery, materials, tools: none*

A story about a family. Distinguishing names of kinship. The genitive singular of nouns and pronouns. Present, past and future tense of verbs. The verb to be. Verb cancellation. Conjugation of verbs and conjugation. Local singular case of nouns. Alternation of consonants. The use of prepositions in, in. Use of connecting connectors.

A story about professions. Local singular case of nouns. Prepositions of place. Exclamatory case of nouns. The genus of nouns to denote the names of professions.

Hobby. Accusative. Constructions "modal word + infinitive". Conjugation of verbs. The order of words in a simple sentence.

- *volume of independent work of applicants: 5*

Elaboration and mastering of the material of lectures and practicals on the topics "Conjugation of verbs", "Use of connecting conjunctions", preparation for the next practical classes. Forming questions to the teacher.

### **Topic 3. Food.**

- *form of classes: lectures, practical classes, independent work.*

- *volume of classroom load: 2-4.*

- *practical classes: "Vegetables and fruits", "Food and drink", "Restaurant".  
Cafe".*

- *Mandatory items and means (equipment, machinery, materials, tools: none*

Names of vegetables and fruits. Colors. Coordination of masculine, feminine and neuter nouns with adjectives in the nominative singular and plural. Closed questions and affirmative or negative answers.

Food and drinks. Coordination of nouns with adjectives, combination of adjective with noun in the genitive and accusative case. Use these cases in a sentence. Present tense of verbs to cook, drink, eat. Past tense verbs eat.

Cooking. The instrumental case of singular and plural nouns of all genera.

Order food. Restaurant. Cafe. Using the menu. Expressions-requests at the table. Nominal case of the set of nouns of all genera. Nouns and plurals. The imperative mood of verbs.

Elaboration and mastering of lecture and practical material on the topics "Colors", "Ukrainian traditional dishes", preparation for the next practical classes. Forming questions to the teacher.

### **Topic 4. Shopping.**

Communication in the grocery store. The genitive case of the plural and the local case of the singular nouns. Relative adjectives. Coordination of quantitative numerals with nouns.

Shopping in the market. Past tense verbs. Diminutive of nouns and adjectives.

In the department store. Clothing and fashion. Dimensions. Ordinal numbers. Adverbs.

Ukrainian souvenirs. Indicative pronouns. Perfect - imperfect form of verbs.

- *volume of independent work of applicants: 5*

Elaboration and mastering of the material of lectures and practicals on the topics "Clothing and footwear", "Ukrainian souvenirs", preparation for the next practical classes. Forming questions to the teacher.

Schools. Teaching. Reverse verbs. The future tense of verbs. Male and female patronymics. Finding excellent nouns with movement verbs. The instrumental case of nouns in the meaning of profession and object. Constructions: you know what..., you know what....

Names of modes of transport and methods of communication. Present tense of verbs (to go, to ride). Distinguish the meanings of these verbs. The instrumental case of nouns (names of transport). Phrases when communicating in transport.

Station. Ordering train tickets. Adverbs of time. Ordinal numbers to denote hours. Phrases used in this situation.

Mail. Phone conversations. Words and phrases used in situations: telephone conversation, remote communication (mail, e-mail). Verbal control. Writing an address.

Our city. Orienteering in the city. Adverbs of place. Names of architectural structures.

- *volume of independent work of applicants: 5*

Elaboration and mastering of lecture and practical material on the topics "Male and female patronymics", "Names of modes of transport", "Address writing", preparation for the next practical classes. Forming questions to the teacher.

Designs to denote a redundant feature (for-).

Elaboration and mastering of the material of lectures and practicals on the topics "My room", "Constructions for the designation of excess (for-)", preparation for the next practical classes. Forming questions to the teacher.

### **Topic 3. Rest.**

Weather description. Names of days of the week, months. Season. Adverbs to denote time intervals. Complex sentences of reason.

Cities of Ukraine. Description of the city of Kharkiv and Kyiv, their comparison. Degrees of comparison of adjectives: formation and use in comparative constructions.

Travel. Conditional way of verbs to denote a desired or possible action, in indirect communicative acts.

Customs. Passing customs control. Filling in the questionnaire with personal data. Negative constructions.

- *volume of independent work of applicants: 5*

Elaboration and mastering of the material of lectures and practical ones on the topics "Names of days of the week, months. Pores of the eye ", " Kharkiv - the city where we study ", " Customs declaration ", preparation for the next practical classes. Forming questions to the teacher.

### **Topic 4. Health.**

- *practical classes: "My working day", "Health".*

My work day. Description of a person's appearance, his emotional state, character. Verbs to denote actions and states.

Health status. Communication with a doctor and a pharmacist. Constructions with modal words: it is possible, it is necessary, it is necessary, it is necessary. Complex sentence conditions.

Sport. Kinds of sport. Sportsmen. Sports vocabulary. Construction of simple sentences.

The test is conducted in the form of testing. The test consists of 20 closed questions (for the correct answer to one question the applicant receives 5 points). During the semester test, the applicant has the opportunity to receive a maximum of 100 points.

### **Criteria for evaluating the applicant's work during the semester**

Satisfactory (60-74). The student passed some practical tasks, did not write all the modular tests. Distinguishes the meaning of lexical units and uses them in a given context, uses prepositional-singular forms of names in the context of utterance, uses verb forms taking into account the context and situation with a significant number of shortcomings, uses the structure of simple and complex sentences in given contexts.

Good (75-89). The student did not pass all the practical tasks in due time, wrote modular tests. The student distinguishes the meanings of lexical units and uses them in a given context, uses prepositional-singular forms of names in the context of utterance, uses verb forms taking into account the context and situation with several errors, uses the structure of simple and complex sentences in given contexts.

Excellent (90-100). The student passed all practical tasks and wrote modular tests in due time. Distinguishes the meaning of lexical units and uses them in a given context, uses prepositional-singular forms of names in the context of expression, uses verb forms taking into account the context and situation with a small number of errors, uses the structure of simple and complex sentences in given contexts.
