What will be studied (subject of study)	<p>As a result of studying the discipline, students will be able to study and expand their knowledge when designing in SolidWorks CAD:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - will be able to create drawings on several sheets for a part; - create sections, local and exploded views, as well as applying dimensions, positions, etc.; - apply dimensions in drawings to fully define the elements to be created, such as arrays and slots; - apply the basic functionality of sheet metal, namely flanges and bends; create a drawing of a sheet metal part; - use the formed parts from the Design Library for more efficient development of sheet metal parts; - to design a welded structure as a single part with the subsequent creation of a drawing; - design molds, create mounting bosses, cores and mold cavities; - will be able to master three methods of designing molds with multiple components. <p>In general, the applicant for education will know the basic and additional material in the field of CAD, generate drawings from models with the addition of all the necessary information according to the standard. Will know the composition and use the tools for designing parts from sheet material, welded structures, casting molds. Will perform practical tasks of creating 3D models within a limited timeframe and will be able to justify the decisions and actions taken</p>
