International Educational Partnerships

The National Aerospace University "Kharkiv Aviation Institute" actively develops international cooperation in the fields of education, science, and innovation.

Partnerships with universities in the European Union, the United Kingdom, Canada, Japan, and the Balkan countries provide opportunities for academic mobility of students and faculty, joint research projects, international conferences, and publications.

The establishment of networked educational programs and dual-degree programs ensures KhAI's integration into the European Higher Education Area and enhances the global competitiveness of Ukrainian higher education.







Partnership with Industry and Business

The National Aerospace University "Kharkiv Aviation Institute" (KhAI) is a reliable partner for industry in creating an innovative ecosystem that integrates education, science, and production.

KhAI actively develops tripartite alliances - "university-business-government"- which promote the commercialization of scientific research, the development of technological entrepreneurship, and the creation of new job opportunities.

Among the key partners are Antonov, Motor Sich, FED, Turboatom, Kharkiv IT Cluster, Style Avia Group, and Boeing, with whom KhAI implements joint research, educational, and engineering projects.
