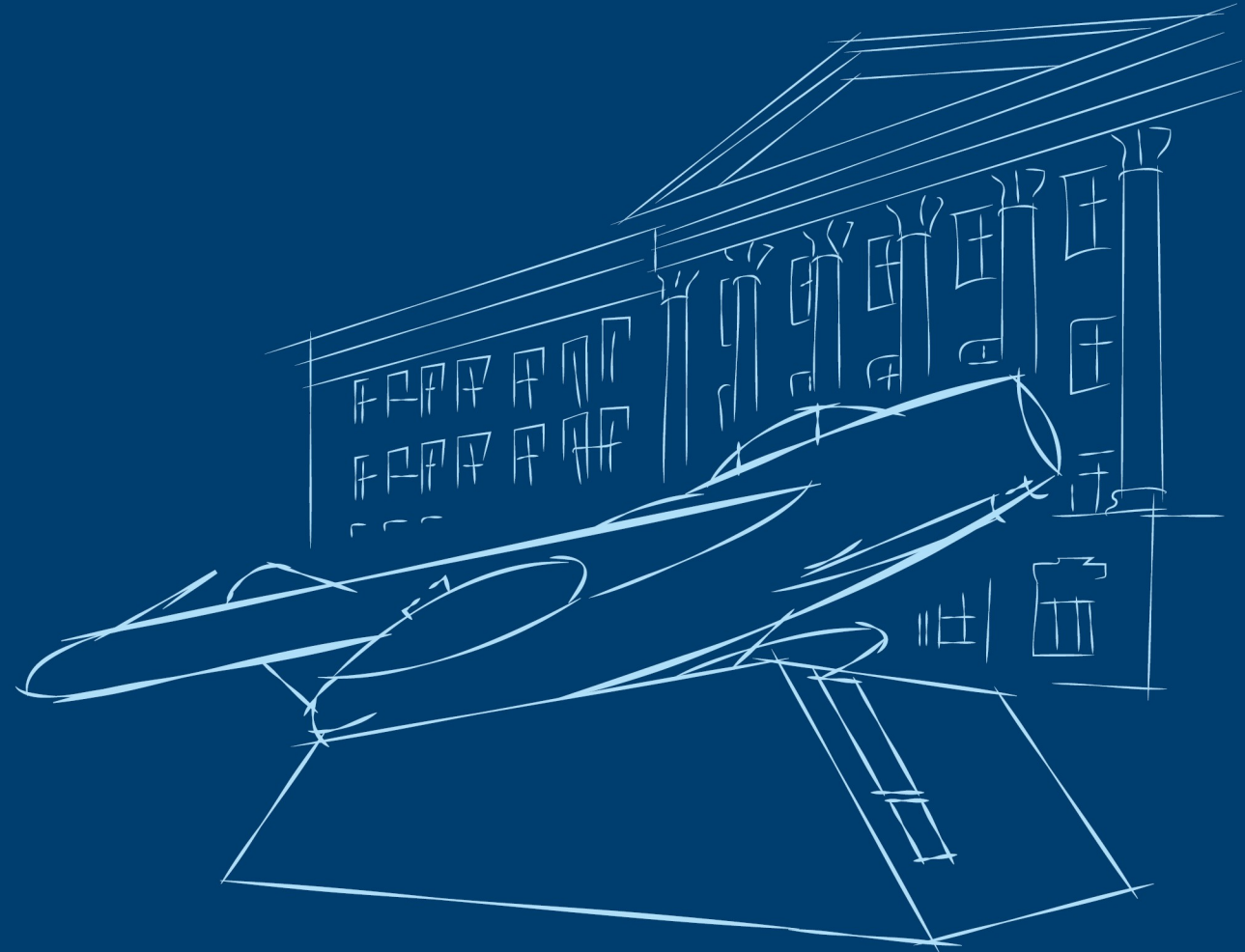

1. Food Security and Food Supplies

One of the key areas of the University's sustainable development is ensuring food stability and security for students and staff. At the National Aerospace University "KhAI," the following measures are implemented:

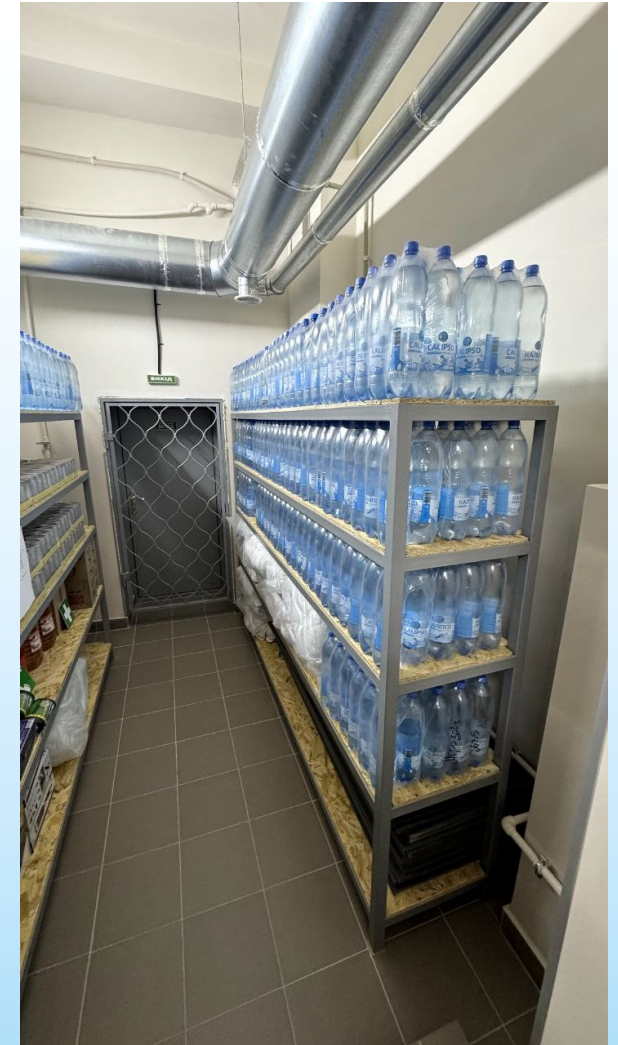
- an efficient university dining system is maintained, with cafeterias and canteens offering affordable, high-quality, and balanced meals;

- a reserve stock of food and drinking water is maintained for use in emergencies;

- environmentally responsible practices are implemented, including reducing food waste, sorting packaging, and transitioning to reusable materials;

- support is provided to socially vulnerable students through free or subsidized meals;

- KhAI operates a safe space equipped with necessary reserves of water, food, and essential supplies, ensuring the university community is prepared to respond in crisis or wartime conditions.



2. Promotion of Healthy Eating

Promoting healthy eating is an integral part of fostering a culture of a healthy lifestyle at the National Aerospace University “KhAI.” The University implements educational programs and informational campaigns aimed at raising students’ awareness of balanced nutrition and the rational consumption of food.

The University’s cafeterias implement healthy menu initiatives, expand the selection of nutritious dishes, and create conditions for mindful eating.

Additionally, themed “Food Sustainability” days are organized to promote environmentally responsible eating, reduce food waste, and support a culture of personal health awareness.

3. Organization of Volunteer Projects

Organizing volunteer projects for the collection and distribution of food is an important aspect of the social responsibility of the National Aerospace University. The university community carries out initiatives to collect and provide food assistance to internally displaced persons, student families, veterans, and local residents facing difficult life circumstances.

Students-volunteers, staff, and university partners are involved in the projects, with logistics, kit preparation, and distribution organized accordingly. Such activities promote a culture of mutual assistance, strengthen solidarity, and support the resilience of the local community.

The University regularly participates in charitable initiatives aimed at supporting internally displaced persons. With the assistance of the Kharkiv Regional Military Administration, food kits are distributed to IDPs on a regular basis, helping to meet the basic needs of people forced to leave their homes. Such systematic support is an important part of the University's social mission and demonstrates its active role in strengthening the region's humanitarian security.



4. Teaching courses and conducting research related to sustainable production technologies, energy efficiency, and food supply logistics is an important part of the academic activities at the National Aerospace University “KhAI.” The curricula include disciplines that develop students’ competencies in resource-efficient practices, environmentally responsible production, and supply chain optimization.

The University’s research teams conduct studies and innovative developments aimed at improving the energy efficiency of industrial processes, implementing technologies to reduce the carbon footprint, and enhancing logistics management systems. This work contributes to the advancement of applied science and the creation of practical solutions for sustainable economic development and social infrastructure.
